## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)**

Kazi Nazrul Islam Mahavidyalaya, Churulia and Deshbandhu Mahavidyalaya, Chittaranjan are UG multi-disciplinary General Degree Colleges affiliated to Kazi Nazrul University, Asansol and are located in the extremes of the coal-belt of West Bengal. The two colleges are linked by common academic interests and thus seek to develop collaborations, exchange in fields of shared interest and expertise. As an extension of these mutual areas of interest the activities of the two Colleges undertaken are to be pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and are to be based on a spirit of cooperation and reciprocity that is intended to be of mutual benefit to both the institutions.

## **I. Purpose**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) serves a written understanding of agreement between Kazi Nazrul Islam Mahavidyalaya, Churulia and Deshbandhu Mahavidyalaya, Chittaranjan based on certain principles concerning a set of general academic activities. This is a non-binding agreement and is intended to clarify the nature and extent of the harmonizing activities and their subsequent benefits that might be undertaken between the two institutions. Each institution shall be responsible for managing its own expenses and share, as and when necessary, the costs of the academic activities accrued thereof. Commitments of specific institutional resources, personnel, space, facilities or any other academic or intellectual activities considered hereunder may or may not be beyond the scope of this MoU. To the extent that the implementation of any agreed upon activity requires a commitment of resources, personnel, credit-bearing coursework, or intellectual property, a supplementary agreement will be negotiated and approved by the two parties before work on any of the projects can commence.

## **II. Objectives, Scope and Major Activities**

Both institutions do hereby agree to encourage the development of the following types of activities:

- Visits and formal exchanges of faculty, scholars and administrators in specific areas of education, pedagogy, research and outreach
- Cooperate in Undergraduate education and training through library as well as laboratory resources.
- Organize joint conferences, symposia and or other Invited Lectures on subjects of mutual interest.
- Exchange of academic information and materials.
- Pursue avenues for undergraduate student-exchange during academic year or through summer/winter internship programmes.
- Explore the possibilities for developing joint research and collaborations.
- Other exchange and cooperation programs such as extension activities to which both institutions agree

### **III. Responsibilities of the Institutions**

The two institutions shall identify that the execution of any agreed upon activity will depend upon the interests and expertise of the individuals involved and the availability of financial resources, space and other resources. Accordingly, the functioning of the exchange and cooperative programs based on this MoU shall be conferred and determined between the two institutions. It is further expected that both institutions will be compliant with all applicable Government of India and State legislations and relevant University policies.

### **IV. Duration and Option to amend, Extend or Terminate the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)**

This MoU will become effective when signed by authorities of both the institutions. The agreement will remain effective for a period of five years from the date of the signature given below, and may be renewed or amended by mutual agreement of the institutions. The institutions should agree to periodically review the activities undertaken and the progress made and to consult concerning amendments, renewal or termination of this MoU. Either authority may terminate this MoU at any time by providing written notice of such termination to termination to the other authority.

### **V. General Terms**

This MoU is not intended to, and does not require any right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or equity, by either party, its officers, employees, or agents against the other party, its officers, employees, or agents. Nothing in this MoU obligates either party to commit or transfer any funds, assets or other resources in support of projects or activities between the two parties. Neither party will use the name of the other, either expressly or by implication, in any publicity, solicitation or advertisement without the express written approval of the other party of this MoU.

V. Signatures

This MoU shall enter into force for a period of five years on and from the date of the signing by the qualified representatives of both institutions

## **A Response to Crises: Literature, Film and Culture of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century**

“And Darkness and Decay and the Red Death held illimitable dominion over all.”

The two day webinar is meant to look into a few issues germane to the conditions of crises and strife faced by academic Humanities, especially in such trying times of social and political disintegrations. Though canonical academia has explored death, disease, dispossession and destruction over the centuries, yet seldom had it ever faced a crises of such magnitude, which necessitated such a philosophical reboot, rendering all earlier academic scaffolding ineffective.

How do Literature, Language, Film and Culture react to conditions of calamities? Has there ever been a meta-response to crises, applicable across spatial and temporal differences? Can Humanities and Social Science survive these calamitous predicaments? Can such crises be historicized? Are there precedents from which present academia can borrow the necessary scaffoldings?

To address such issues, the Department of English, Deshabandhu Mahavidyalaya, Chittaranjan, seeks to organize a two-day gathering of eminent speakers from various Departments of the Humanities school in India.

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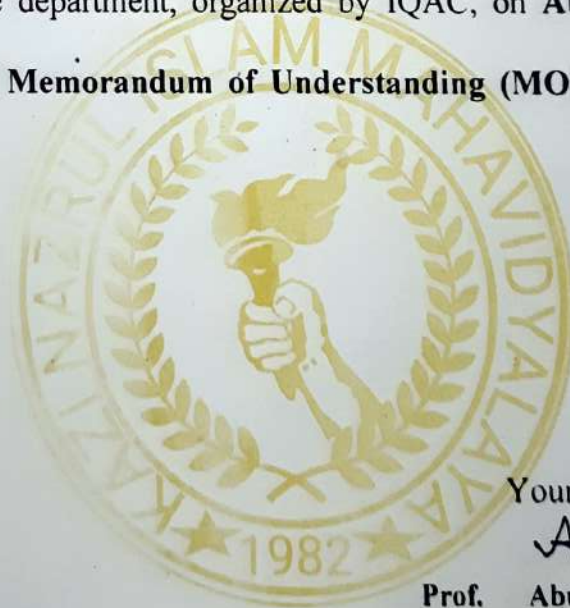
